Strategic Engagement:

Social media channels are also a fast and easy way to reach many community members with various messages.

- Instagram - 12 p.m. to 1 p.m. EST, Monday to Friday.
- LinkedIn - 7:45 a.m., 10:45 a.m., 12:45 p.m., and 5:45 p.m. EST. Monday and Wednesday.
